In a word, traffic. Whether voicing your concerns about parking problems on neighborhood streets. congestion on Hwy 39, or questions about the impact of the new elementary school, many residents have been asking about traffic lately.

New School. More Volume?


With the construction of Forest Oaks Elementary slated to open in Fall 2013, other area schools will be impacted. The Chelsea Park and Mt. Laurel Elementary schools will be restructured to serve grades K-5 (as will Forest Oaks). The Chelsea Middle School will continue to serve grades 6-8, expanding into the adjoining building currently occupied by the Chelsea Intermediate School.

Because of new school construction, County Road 337 was closed on August 20th up to the Brookchase subdivision. It will remain closed until the new paved Forest Oaks Blvd. is completed - it will run from the new school to Hwv 47. So how will all of this affect traffic issues on Hwy 39, Hwy 47 & CR 337?

In a telephone conversation on Sept. 19th with Mayor Niven, he was asked if the city had proposed entrance /exit solutions for the new school or solutions to help alleviate current traffic issues on the surrounding highways.

He responded with an awareness of the school traffic issues. An immediate remedy

will be the opening of Forest Oaks Blvd, with new school traffic flowing into Hwy 47. To address other traffic issues. the long term plan (1-2 years) is to realign the junction of Hwy 47 & 39 (see map below). From Yellowleaf, Hwy 39 would continue east to the railroad tracks on the left side of the old store near City Hall. A new road would connect Hwy. 47 (near Liberty Baptist Church) and Hwy 39 (near Twin Oaks subdivision). Both county and state officials will be involved in the proposed plan, thus determining the timeline and start date.

Concerns remain over traffic issues at the entrance due to school drop-offs and pickups. Letters sent to middle and intermediate school principals last Spring eliminated the problem of cars lining up inside the neighborhood entrance, and we remain vigilant in case it reoccurs. One suggestion that may also help is for Yellowleaf parents to park further down inside the entranceway so that needed U-turns back into the subdivision would below the island.
